PRODUCTION

All kinds of ceramic bodies are produced at the plant; they could be as:

- as a press-powder for slip casting,
- in a wet state as the body for plastic forming,
- as a granulated powder for isostatic pressing.

PRODUCTS

The end production is ceramic body, representing itself as the complex and precisely balanced composition of natural minerals: clay, kaolin, sand, feldspar, pegmatite etc. these ceramic bodies are intended for application in the ceramic industry as the main component of such products as porcelain and faience artistic-domestic wares, insulators, souvenirs, building and technical ceramics.

The trade mark ECOBODY was developed and registered for the line of the ecologically clean production in 2009. The products of this batch are produced from natural minerals, tested thoroughly on the ecological and radiological indices, with application of the most modern control and production methods.
